**CHALLENGES AND PROSPECTS IN SUPPORTING INSTITUTIONAL ACADEMIC
INTEGRITY THROUGH LIBRARY'S SERVICES IN CENTRAL ASIA REGION:

Libraries become increasingly involved in raising students awareness about academic integrity through information literacy program.
